

To qualify for an AAT or ATT Apprenticeship position with Armstrong Watson you must have achieved a minimum of 7 GCSEs at Grade 5 (C) or above, or 6 National Fives, including Maths, English and at least one Science, and already have achieved or be predicted to achieve a minimum of 96 UCAS points obtained at A Level, Scottish Highers or BTEC Level 3 or above. You must also be at least 18 years of age by 31 August 2025.


